

BIENVILLE PLANTATION TOURNAMENT ***“NO STRESS TO CATCH THE BIG ONE”***

Bienville Plantation is excited to announce the ***“NO STRESS TO CATCH THE BIG ONE”*** tournament, at Bienville Plantation. The entry fee is \$200.00 per boat. There will only be (1) payout with a minimum of \$500.00 and a maximum of \$1000.00 for the boat that catches/weigh-in the most fish within the 8 to 15-inch slot limit. The tournament will be held on ***June 15, 2019*** from 7:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M. Results and presentation of the cash awards will be held at the Main Lodge at 3:00 P.M.

As part of our ongoing effort to manage our bass population between 8 to 15 inches, we have decided that instead of us trying to do this on a monthly, weekly, or daily basis we figured we let y'all have all the fun!

REGISTRATION

TOURNAMENT RULES

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PAYOUT

- 1.** This is a total fish tournament NO fish will be weighed in. EXAMPLE: A ½ pound bass counts the same towards your total number of fish as a 1.5 pound bass so long as they are a minimum of 8 inches and no longer than 15.00 inches in length.
- 2.** Check-in will be from 5:30 A.M. to 6:30 A.M. at Bienville Plantation's Main Lodge. After check-in you will immediately proceed to your designated lake to launch your boat. After launching your boat, you will wait for the start of the tournament. Winners will be announced at the Main Lodge at the check-in area immediately after the tournament.
- 3.** If you are not at Bienville Plantation's Main Lodge by 6:30 A.M. for check-in you will be immediately disqualified, and your entry fee will be forfeited.

4. Boats will leave the designated ramp based on their assigned boat number in numerical order.
5. Any boats that leave prior to their assigned number will be immediately disqualified.
6. Boat numbers will be drawn for at time of check-in and must be kept on person for the entirety of the tournament.
7. Tournament begins at 7:00 a.m. and all boats must be at the ramp by 2:00 P.M. For every minute that you are late to weigh-in you will be penalized 3 fish per minute off your total number of fish, and after 5 minutes you will be automatically disqualified.
8. Weigh-in/fish count will open at 12:30 P.M. Once you weigh-in you must immediately trailer your boat.
9. Bienville Plantation has a blanket fishing license, so no one will be required to have a Florida Fresh Water Fishing License.
10. All fish are the sole and exclusive property of Bienville Plantation.
11. All people, boats and/or vehicles may be randomly inspected by Bienville Plantation staff and/or Law enforcements officers, that will be present at: (1). At any time during pre-fishing, (2). Check-in at Main Lodge, and (3). Upon departure after your boat has been trailered, (4) Anytime on Bienville Plantation premises.
12. Anyone caught with any bream, crappie, bass, and or any other fish alive or dead in their possession after their boat has been trailered maybe be prosecuted and/or fined up to: (1). \$15.00 per pound for each fish which is less than 15.01 inches in length, and/or (2). \$80.00 per pound, per fish that is greater than 15.01 inches in length. Example If you attempt to leave the plantation and you have a 5.5 lb. fish and ½ pound fish your fine will be \$447.50. The bottom line is that if you are caught trying to leave the plantation with fish without our express written permission, you are stealing, so PLEASE DON'T. We want everyone that comes to Bienville Plantation not to just have a good time but a great time. Bienville only has a few rules, but we will enforce them vigorously.
13. Must have functioning live well.
14. Once you have entered the tournament there will be no refunds for “No Shows”, no exceptions!
15. You **WILL NOT** be penalized for dead fish
16. You will be **penalized** for the following rule violations:
 - A. Any fish over 15.01 inches (penalized 6 fish off total number)
 - B. Any fish under 8.00 inches (penalized 4 fish off total number)

17. Your team will be **immediately disqualified**, your entry fee will be forfeited, and be required to immediately trailer your boat, and leave Bienville Plantation premises for the following rule violations:
- A. No more than two (2) people per boat
 - B. No live bait of any kind
 - C. ALL lakes are Idle Speed Only
18. Each member of every team shall present valid identification, acknowledge and sign off that you understand and accept ALL Tournament rules, and sign a Bienville waiver prior to launching your boat. If this is not done, then you are automatically eliminated from the tournament and forfeit your entry fee. If there is a tie between one or more boats, then the tie break will be divided equally.
